She is now involved in researching solders from the American Revolution that came to Northern Kentucky after the war because of land they were given land grants for serving in the Revolution. She wants to inform families about their connections to the American Revolution that most don't know about.

Pam's husband, Kent, was an agent for the Treasury Department. He retired, but because of his background and knowledge, he travels all over the United States and the world teaching classes. She has been able to travel with him. She has been to every state and many countries. China, Russia, Thailand, and India to name a few. She also travels with her family because her grandkids are in the Beechwood Band. They have traveled to National Competitions with them.

Pam is a member of the Northern Kentucky Heritage League and the Kenton County Retired Teachers. She went to Frankfort with KCRT to lobby for returning funds to Kentucky Teacher's retirement and protecting health care for teachers. Pam is an April 6, 2015 graduate of the Kenton County Government Academy. This class was the 9th annual and had 24 students. Stacy Tapke chairs the academy. It is a 30-hour program that meets once a week for 10 weeks and Pam highly recommends it for everyone.
