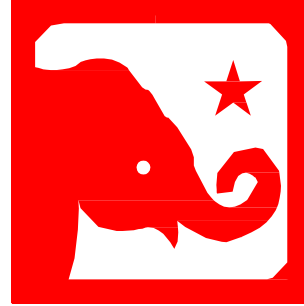


# Kenton County Republican Women's Club

#### **THE MARY MIDDLETON SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION**

**The Mary Middleton Scholarship is presented annually to a student who understands the importance of civic engagement within the young adult community. The \$500 scholarship is named in honor of KCRWC's founder, Mary Middleton, who dedicated over fifty years of service to the organization. A tireless volunteer, Mary devoted significant personal energies to public and community service.**

**Applicants must be residents of Kenton County attending a Kenton County High School or be home schooled. The applicant must begin his or her post-secondary education at an accredited school for either a two-year or four-year degree in the summer or fall of 2016.**

**The Mary Middleton Scholarship program is administered under the supervision of the KCRWC Scholarship Committee. The committee is responsible for the implementation of the program, including the recruitment of applicants and the selection of the Scholarship Award winner. Application deadline is midnight, Saturday, April 2, 2016. A decision will be made by April 30, 2016. Late or incomplete essays will not be considered. The Scholarship will be presented on Monday, May 23, 2016 at the KCRWC luncheon.**

***The last day the Republican Party of Kentucky will accept absentee applications will be February 19, 2016.***

**Completed absentee ballots must be received at the state party headquarters by 5:00 pm ET on Friday, March 4, 2016.**

A voter will become ineligible to vote in person at any caucus location once an absentee ballot has been mailed to the voter.

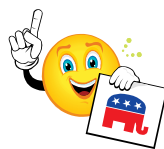

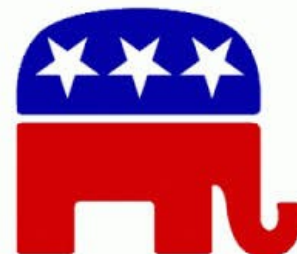
