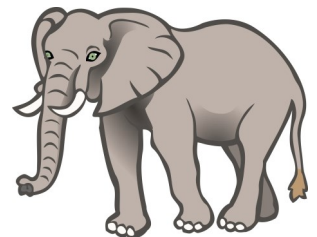

Mail-in absentee ballot requests can be made online at www.govote.ky.gov or call (859) 392-1620. Absentee portal is open from April 6 to May 7

Drop boxes for absentee ballots are available at the Kenton County Government Center (1840 Simon Kenton Way in Covington) or the Historic Kenton County Courthouse (5272 Madison Pike in Independence).



IN-PERSON ABSENTEE (EXCUSE REQUIRED)

In-person absentee voting will be available at the Kenton County Government Center (1840 Simon Kenton Way in Covington) on May 8, May 9, May 10, May 13, May 14 & May 15 from 7:30 AM - 4 PM



EARLY IN-PERSON (NO EXCUSE REQUIRED)

Early voting centers will be available on May 16, May 17 & May 18 from 7:30 AM to 4:00 PM. Early voting centers allow you to go to any available location. Available locations are online at www.kentoncountyclerk.com under Where to Vote.



THERE IS NO VOTING ON MONDAY, MAY 20, 2024

ELECTION DAY- MAY 21, 2024 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.

You can go to any polling location to vote to receive your precinct specific ballot. If you require a pre-printed ballot you must go to the location assigned to your precinct.
